At a recent news conference, Viktor Voronin, a citizen from Ukraine and pastor of Grace of Christ Slavic Church, addressed the refugee crisis unfolding in Ukraine. “We received a note from one of them yesterday,” he said. “People are hiding in dungeons or bomb shelters. They absolutely can’t help themselves.” At this time, it is difficult to get supplies into the country so monetary donations are the only thing being accepted.
