10 Tips for Financial Literacy Month

- 10. **Ask for help:** Don't be afraid to ask for help from a financial advisor or the financial aid office at your school.



RECIPE OF THE MONTH

Turkey Burgers

Ingredients:

- 2 lb. ground turkey
- 1/4 c. mayonnaise
- 1/4 c. panko or regular breadcrumbs
- 1 tbsp. Worcestershire sauce
- 11/2 tsp. seasoned salt
- 1/2 tsp. ground black pepper
- 1 tbsp. vegetable oil
- 6 toasted buns

Optional toppings:

- pesto mayonnaise (1/4 cup mayo + 1 tablespoon prepared pesto)
- red leaf lettuce
- o avocado
- o swiss cheese

Instructions:

- 1.In a large bowl, combine the ground turkey, mayonnaise, breadcrumbs, Worcestershire, seasoned salt, and black pepper. Mix gently to combine well. Divide the mixture into 6 even portions (about 6 ounces each). Pat together into a tight ball, then press into a patty, 3/4-inch thick.
- 2.On the stovetop: Heat a large cast-iron skillet over medium-high heat. Add 1 tablespoon vegetable oil and swirl to coat the pan. Place the patties in the skillet and let cook for 5 minutes. Flip and cook the other side until the internal temperature of the turkey burger reaches 165°, about 5 more minutes. If you like cheese on your burgers, add it during the last minute of cooking, then cover to melt.

3. Alternatively cook on the grill:

Preheat the grill to medium-high heat, 400 to 425°. Oil the grill grates. Place the patties on the grill over direct heat. Cook for 4 to 5 minutes per side, covered, or until the internal temperature reads 165°. If you like cheese on your burgers, add during the last minute of cooking, then cover to melt.

Security Corner

If you or a loved one were solicited through a computer pop-up, social media site, dating site, text, email, or phone call by someone you have never met, and answer "YES" to one of the following questions, you may have been targeted by a scam:

- Have you been asked to invest in cryptocurrency or in gold futures?
- Has someone claiming to be a bank or government agency requested money, or for you to liquidate your accounts, in order to clear you of a crime or secure your accounts?
- Has someone claiming to be a tech or customer support representative requested money to remove a virus or child pornography from your computer or secure your account?
- Has someone you never met claimed to be romantically interested in you but requests you send them money or something else of value?
- Has someone asked you to obtain cash to either purchase gift cards or deposit in a cryptocurrency ATM
 —or given you a QR code to deposit money into an ATM?
