

RECIPE OF THE MONTH



Fresh Southern Peach Cobbler

INGREDIENTS

- 8 fresh peaches peeled, pitted, and sliced into thin wedges
- ¼ cup white sugar
- ¼ cup brown sugar
- ¼ teaspoon ground cinnamon
- ½ teaspoon ground nutmeg
- 1 teaspoon fresh lemon juice
- 2 teaspoons cornstarch
- 1 cup all-purpose flour

- ¼ cup white sugar
- ¼ cup brown sugar
- 1 teaspoon baking powder
- ½ teaspoon salt
- 6 tablespoons unsalted butter, chilled and cut into small pieces
- ¼ cup boiling water
- 3 tablespoons white sugar
- 1 teaspoon ground cinnamon

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Gather all ingredients and preheat the oven to 425 degrees.
- 2. Combine peaches, 1/4 cup white sugar, 1/4 cup brown sugar, 1/4 teaspoon cinnamon, nutmeg, lemon juice, and cornstarch in a large bowl; toss to coat evenly, and pour into a 2-quart baking dish. Bake in preheated oven for 10 minutes.
- 3. Combine flour, 1/4 cup white sugar, 1/4 cup brown sugar, baking powder, and salt in a large bowl. Blend in butter with your fingertips or a pastry blender until mixture resembles coarse meal. Stir in water until just combined.
- 4. Remove peaches from oven and drop spoonfuls of topping over them.
- 5. Mix 3 tablespoons white sugar and 1 teaspoon cinnamon together in a small bowl; sprinkle over entire cobbler.
- 6. Bake in the preheated oven until topping is golden, about 30 minutes.

Counterfeit United States Savings Bonds

Security Corner

The U.S. Secret Service has confirmed the U.S. Department of the Treasury has identified an increase in activity associated with fraudulent United States Savings Bonds (Series EE and Series I). This fraud scheme often involves fraudsters relying on individuals to cash the counterfeit bonds for a share of the illicit profit. The volume of counterfeit bonds is consistently growing, with estimated loss amounts being reported at \$30 million. Please remain alert. State bonds are not used for quick cash and customers should not accept them from unknown individuals or entities. If instructed to redeem a savings bond by another party for a partial payout or other benefit, IT'S A SCAM! Please reach out to our Fraud Department at (812) 492-8200 if you have any questions.
