Scammers are impersonating our Bank's Fraud Department to steal online banking information.



If you've shared info or see unusual activity, contact us immediately.



Follow the steps below to lock out your debit card:



To lockout the card, click the toggle on the right. It will have you confirm the change.



The card status will now show as off. Until this is turned back on, all transactions except for recurring transactions will be denied.

RECIPE OF THE MONTH



White Chocolate Candy Cane Cookies

INGREDIENTS

- 21/2 cups flour
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1 teaspoon baking powder
- 1 teaspoon baking soda
- 2 sticks (16 tablespoons) butter, at room temperature
- 1/2 cup sugar
- 1 cup dark brown sugar
- 2 large eggs
- 2 teaspoons vanilla
- 11/2 cups white chocolate chips
- 1 cup crushed candy canes, leave dust behind

<u>INSTRUCTIONS</u>

- 1. Preheat oven to 350°. Line a baking sheet with parchment paper and set aside.
- 2. In a mixing bowl, whisk together flour, salt, baking powder, and baking soda. Set aside.
- 3. In your mixer, cream butter and sugars. Add eggs and vanilla and mix until combined.
- 4. Gently stir the flour mixture into the butter mixture; mix until thoroughly combined.
- 5. Stir in the chopped white chocolate and crushed candy canes.
- 6. Spoon out generous tablespoons of dough onto the prepared cookie sheets, leaving 2-inches between cookies.
- 7. Bake for 8 to 10 minutes, or until the edges are light brown. Slightly under-baking makes for a chewy cookie.
- 8. Remove from oven, let cool for a couple minutes, then transfer to a cooling rack.

Is it a Scam?

Security Corner

What are the signs of a scam?

Scammers contact you unexpectedly and claim there's a problem — like money owed to the government, a family emergency, or a computer virus. They pressure you to act fast so you don't have time to think. They demand payment through specific methods, such as:

- Gift cards (sharing the numbers on the back)
- Wire transfers (e.g., MoneyGram, Western Union)
- Cryptocurrency
- Payment apps

How do I protect myself from scammers?

Take your time — legitimate organizations won't rush you. Never pay anyone who insists on gift cards, wire transfers, cryptocurrency, or payment apps.
