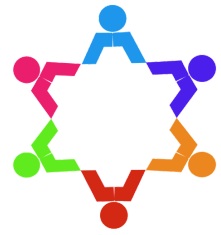

- Between 12 and 17 characters
- At least 1 number
- At least 1 uppercase letter
- At least 1 lowercase letter
- At least 1 special character

For an added layer of security, we also encourage you to use additional safeguards when available, such as multi-factor authentication (MFA), facial recognition, etc.

RECIPE OF THE MONTH



No-Bake Strawberry Blueberry Trifle

Blueberry Trifle Ingredients:

- 17 oz angel food cake, cut into 1" cubes
- 1 lb fresh strawberries, hulled and sliced
- 1 lb fresh blueberries
- 4 or 5 qt trifle dish

Lemon Syrup Ingredients:

- 1/4 cup water
- 2 Tbsp sugar
- 2 Tbsp lemon juice, from 1/2 medium lemon

Frosting Ingredients:

- 8 oz cream cheese, softened at room temp
- 3/4 cup granulated sugar
- 2 cups heavy whipping cream
- 1/2 tsp vanilla extract

INSTRUCTIONS

How to Make Lemon Syrup:

In a measuring cup, combine 1/4 cup water, 2 Tbsp sugar and 2 Tbsp lemon juice and stir until sugar is dissolved. Set aside until needed.

How to Make the Trifle Cream:

Beat together 1 lb cream cheese and 3/4 cup sugar (with the whisk attachment) on medium speed until creamy and smooth, scraping the bowl a couple times. With mixer on, pour in 2 cups heavy cream then turn mixer to medium/high and continue beating until whipped and fluffy. Add 1/2 tsp vanilla and beat until incorporated.

Assembling the Berry Trifle:

Place 1/3 of your sliced angel food cake into the bottom of your trifle dish and brush with 1/3 of your syrup. Add 1/3 of your cream and loosely spread it over cake pieces. Add 1/2 of the sliced strawberries. Repeat with remaining ingredients (adding 1/2 of the blueberries for the second fruit layer). Frost the top with last 1/3 of cream and decorate with remaining fruit.

DON'T IGNORE THE SIGNS

SECURITY CORNER

Fraudsters are currently using various methods to convince consumers to send them information and/or money. Whether it's impersonating a business you're familiar with or disguising as someone wanting to help, there are red flags to look for to help you spot a scam.

These are 5 **DON'Ts** you should remember and follow:

1. **DON'T** give out your username or password for your online banking.
2. **DON'T** give out your online banking security code. It should **ONLY** be used by you. Never forward it to someone else.
3. **DON'T** rely on contact information from an unexpected email, call, or text. Inspect and research!
4. **DON'T** be pressured to act immediately. Honest businesses will give you time to make a decision.
5. **DON'T** ignore your gut. If it sounds too good to be true, it probably is!
